Meet the Presenters

Allen Chartier is the Project Director for the Great Lakes HummerNet, a research project created in 2001 and aimed at learning more about hummingbirds with the help of volunteer observers throughout Michigan, and investigating wintering hummingbirds in the Great Lakes region. He has been interested in science and nature since he was 5 years old, and began birdwatching when he was 11. Since he was married in 1979, he has been on birdina trips to 28 countries with his wife



Nancy, and they have birded in all 50 U.S. states. Allen has been a photographer since 1979 and switched over to digital in 2005. He has been a bird bander since 1997 and a hummingbird bander since 2000 when he began the Great Lakes HummerNet research project after obtaining his U.S. Federal Master Bird Banding Permit, and Michigan DNR Permit. He was co-editor of "A Birder's Guide to Michigan" published by the American Birding Association (ABA) in 2004 (reprinted in 2010), and has been a contributing author for various projects with National Geographic including "Complete Birds of North America", "Complete Birds of the World", and "Handheld Birds." Allen was lead editor of the "Second Michigan Breeding Bird Atlas" (online 2011) and "Michigan Breeding Bird Atlas II" (print 2013). In 2018, he authored a "Field Guide to Birds of Michigan" published by the ABA. Allen's interests also include Reptiles and Amphibians (especially salamanders), Butterflies and Moths, Beetles, Dragonflies, Spiders, Wildflowers (especially Orchids); and basically any form of life that he can attempt to identify.
